Call for Applications

The U.S. Embassy in Kigali, Rwanda, is pleased to announce the 2019-2020 Hubert H. Humphrey Fellowship Program. This one-year, full-scholarship program is offered to mid-career professionals working at the policy-level who have a record of leadership, a commitment to public service, and the initiative to take full advantage of a self-defined program of independent study at a leading American university.

The Hubert H. Humphrey Fellowship Program brings accomplished professionals from developing countries to the United States at a midpoint in their careers for a one-year program of non-degree study and related professional activities. The program seeks to foster an exchange of knowledge and mutual understanding between American citizens and professional counterparts from Rwanda. Successful applicants will be placed at participating universities in the United States for the August 2019-June 2020 academic year.

Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for a Humphrey Fellowship, applicants must have:

- A Bachelor's degree
- Five years of substantial professional experience following university degree
- Demonstrated leadership qualities and a record of public service
- Leadership position whose responsibilities provide direct policy input or impact .
- Fluency or functional English experience

Application/Selection Process

Interested applicants must complete and submit their applications through the Embark online application system at <https://ie.embark.com/apply/humphreyfellowship2019> no later than July 20, 2018. Unlike previous years, applications submitted via email or hard copies will not be accepted.

Grant Provisions

The Hubert Humphrey Fellowship provides:

- Round-trip economy international travel for the grantee;
- Tuition and university fees, settling-in and monthly maintenance allowances, funding for books and professional activities ;
- Limited accident and sickness insurance but does not include pre-existing conditions and pregnancy.

The Humphrey Program does not provide financial support for accompanying dependents.
